

This document shows how to access the parmaite letters on macintosh non-unicode applications (such as AppleWorks 6 or Microsoft Word for Mac or BBedit Lite). It does NOT work on unicode applications (such asTextEdit) – I don't know why (but it's no problem to access all letters in unicode applications). At least, that's how it is on OSX 10.2.1 Jaguar.

Red signs refer to letters that are in the tengwar parmaite alt found. ^ refers to the shift modicator, ~ to the alt modicator (these aren't consistently indicated)
